The Asian Society for Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgery (ASCVTS)

ASCVTS traces its origins back to 1973 when it was established as the Asian Chapter of ISCVS, the International Society for Cardiovascular Surgery. Founded by esteemed cardiovascular surgeons such as Drs. DeBakey, Haimovici and other eminent cardiovascular surgeons.

In 1992, ASCVS initiated collaboration between Korea, Taiwan, and Japan, marking a significant expansion of its reach and influence. The inaugural meeting took place in Fukuoka, Japan, in 1993, laying the groundwork for collaborative efforts in the field of cardiovascular surgery.

ASCVS's evolution continued with a strategic shift in 2004. As ISCVS restructured to focus solely on vascular surgery (becoming ISVS), ASCVS gained independence. Recognising the broader spectrum of cardiovascular care, ASCVS embraced this opportunity to redefine itself. By 2008, this commitment to comprehensive patient care manifested in the incorporation of thoracic surgery, transforming ASCVS into ASCVTS.

Today, ASCVTS boasts over 1000 members from 30 countries. We stand on a legacy of excellence, fostering education, research, and collaboration to improve patient outcomes across Asia
